The **Full Report** is based on performance during the term and the end of year examination. It comprises a series of individually prepared sheets by the following persons:

- Subject Teacher
- Form Teacher
- Head of Year/Principal
- Parent/Guardian

All information given for the Interim Report is entered on the Full Report.
