Sixth Form Studies (Advanced Level)

Any student who obtains a minimum of **five** (5) passes at CXC-CSEC, preferably grades I and II, or the equivalent at alternative boards qualifies to enter Sixth Form. Studies cover two years leading to the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE).
